BLADES FOR GRADES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

“Blades for Grades” is a scholarship program sponsored by the Chatham Maroon Alumni Association for the Chatham Jr. Maroon players who are furthering their education beyond high school in a CANADIAN POST SECONDARY INSTITUTION.

GUIDELINES

Jr. Maroon players may be eligible for a scholarship for each year they played for the Maroon Hockey Club starting in the 1999-2000 season.

The scholarship will be paid at the end of the first completed term(s) in the school year(s) (September to August) after the player has provided a Transcript of Academic Record.

An application form must be filled out by the applicant before he is eligible for a scholarship.

Payment amount and continuation of the scholarship program will be determined each year (at the annual meeting) based on available alumni funds and amounts committed to players from previous years.

Successful candidates for this scholarship must be a carded Jr. Maroon player. A carded player is one whose name is on the Maroon’s OHA Final Roster Sheet which has a January submission date of the qualifying year.

Players must apply for this scholarship program within 2 years of leaving the Jr. Maroons. Applicants must attend school in consecutive years to be eligible for any scholarships owing them.

Players receiving a full or partial U.S. scholarship are not eligible for this Canadian Post Secondary scholarship program. A player whose intentions are to receive an NCAA scholarship and has earned potential scholarship funds through the “Blades for Grades” program will not have those funds delivered until his NCAA eligibility has been disqualified.

Players signing an OHL or CHL standard player’s agreement or a pro contract are not eligible for any benefits from the “Blades for Grades” program.
